

# GONE GREEN

Phoenix Park's solar energy system is one of the largest renewable energy projects in Massachusetts. The installation of 2,530 rooftop and ground level panels is predicted to offset the facility's electrical load by approximately 40%. Phoenix Park has taken a number of additional measures in effort to "go green" with energy efficient windows, energy efficient HVAC systems, energy efficient lighting, maximum roof insulation, low flow plumbing fixtures, and waste stream recycling.

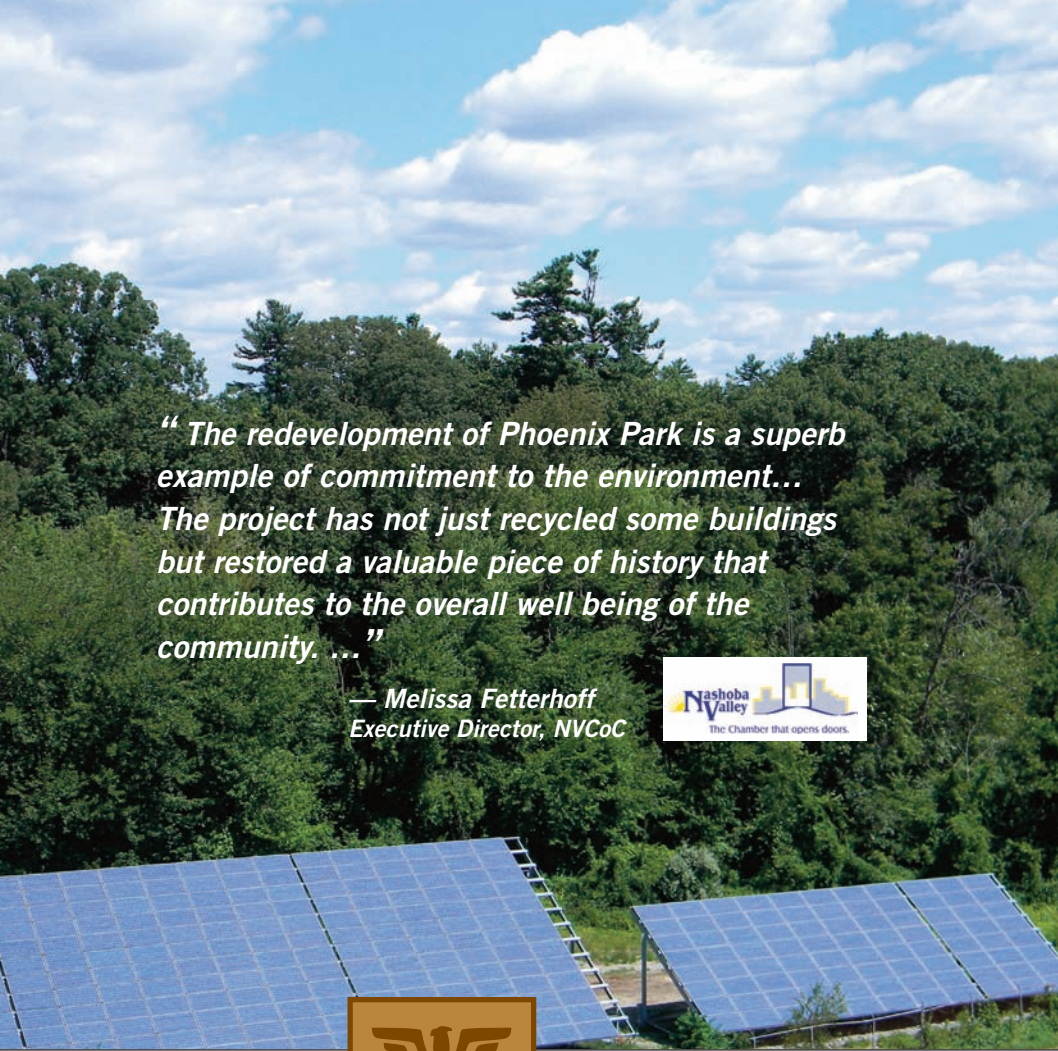
